FAES Award Rules

FAES Award Committee constituted with Dr Amit Agarwal, Dr Sai Krishna Vittal, Dr Anand Mishra and Dr P V Pradeep made the following recommendations

- The applicant prior to his application should have had a presentation (either paper or poster) in one IAES Annual Conference
- The applicant should come for credentialing in one IAES Annual Conference
- If credentialing is successful, then he or she should be allowed to get his FAES in a subsequent IAES Annual Conference
- The fee for FAES should be fixed at Rs 20000 plus certificate fee of Rs 750
- The applicant should be a life member of ASI and IAES
- The applicant should be a life member of IAES for a minimum period of three years
- The two referees should be members of IAES for a minimum period of three years
- The Credential Committee will be constituted by the President and the Honorary Secretary of that year.
- Candidates with MCh in Endocrine Surgery will be allowed to apply directly provided they have attended two IAES Annual Conference.

The General Body accepted the recommendations.

Dr Dhalpathy suggested that FAES would not be recognized by Medical Council of India. President Dr Amit Agarwal mentioned that IAES was not a licensing authority and being a Section of Association of Surgeons of India was following the norms of FAIS given by Association of Surgeons of India. President Dr Amit Agarwal agreed that a disclaimer can be added in the FAES Application that award of FAES alone does not make the awardee a specialist Endocrine Surgeon.
